In the Knowledge Fest conducted by the ECO club of Holy Cross, our school team got the First prize in the Powerpoint presentation, Second prize in start up business, and First prize in debate. Rohan was adjudged the Best speaker.

In the inter school competitions conducted by the Old Students' Association of Sri Sarada College of Education, our school won a lot of prizes in various competitions.

In the Kalai panbaattu thiruvizha competitions conducted by Padmavani college, our students participated and won many prizes at the district level. Ashwin Kumar went on to the state level and got the second prize in the Karnatic Vocal competition.

As we were the winners of Kalothsav, we were given special invitations to perform during their Diamond Jubilee celebrations at Holy Cross.

This year through Aakam, we have taken up an ambitious project "Kuppai illa Kondapanaickenpatty"

It is with the objective of house-to-house collection of segregated waste which in turn will lead to zero waste in the village. We had the active support of the local MLA Mr. Arul, the panchayat president and members and the officials. With a generous donation from the parents and the public, we have got 3 vehicles to augment the waste collection of the panchayat by taking up full responsibility for 3 major wards. We capped the erstwhile dumpyard at Senguttai with mines soil, built a shed to house a shredding machine to shred wet waste and an incinerator to dispose diapers and sanitary pads and a yard to convert the shredded wet waste into rich manure. The recyclables are sorted and sold. Plastic is also graded and some are sold to waste merchants and the rest are sent to cement factories to be used as fuel. Our students play an active role by creating awareness on the need to segregate waste and also pool in money to buy gifts for the sanitary workers on a monthly basis. We do face a different challenge everyday but are striving to make our dream come true.

#### Skating

In the Salem District Students Cricket Association events, our school team got the second place at the district level. In the under 17 category, Nakul Varshan got selected for the state cricket team. Shravan Krisshna, was selected for the Tamilnadu Under 14 Cricket team. Sonakshi was selected to play in the Salem district team by the Tamilnadu Cricket Association and she got the best player award.

Now we move onto to the Salem Sahodaya Games. We participated in the various events that are a part of the annual Salem Sahodaya Games for the year 2023-24. We did extremely well and had an almost clean sweep. We do a great job every year and this year was no exception. Here is the list of our achievements.

In football, both our under 19 girls team and under 14 boys team won the gold.

In Basketball, both the boys and girls teams of our school were winners in the under 19 category.

In athletics, with our skyscraping performances, our school team was placed second overall. In the under 19 category, Sundaramoorthy got the overall individual championship with his gold in both discus, and javelin throw. He along with Akash, Praveen and Keshav won the gold in the 4x100m relay. In the under 17 category, Mithun got a gold in 100m and silver in longjump. In the under 14 category, Senthalir got a gold in longjump and a bronze in the 100m sprint. Mridula got a silver in discus throw, Keshav got a bronze in 100m, Mayank got a bronze in high jump. Sindhuvarshini, Rajashri, Snigdha, and Sreenithi got a bronze in 4x100m relay. Mahitha, Pavithra, Gunalakshika and Oviya got a silver



in 4x100m relay. Pavithra got a bronze in 200m. In table tennis, Shivam and Aarya got a gold in the Under 19 doubles, Anirudh and Agathiya got a gold in the under 14 doubles and Mozhivendhan got a gold in the under 19 singles. Hiranmayi and Arthi Rajaraman got a silver in the under 19 girls doubles.

In archery, Ashwin got a gold in the under 14 category and Mithun Karthik got a gold in the under 17 category. In the under 17 category for girls, Pradhaniya got a silver.

In chess, in the under 19 boys category, our school team with Prahadeesh, Sai Nimhalan, Gokula Krishna, and Arun Karthik were gold winners and Janani, Harshinee, Magizhini and Harshita were winners in the under 19 girls category.

In yoga, Sneha, Toufiya, Charanya and Sriharini got the gold in the under 19 category. Vimal, Sai Ganesh, Arvind and Nithik got a silver in the under 14 category.
